


CONTENTS:





ASSEMBLY

The improper assembly of this product can lead to serious injury of your child. Ensure that the 35114 Change Table is assembled as per these instructions.

Step 1. Unpack contents.

Step 2. Attach the Top & Bottom Shelf Side Rails (2 & 3) to the End Panel (1) by using 6 x 50mm Bolts (A), 6 x Wood Dowels (B) & 6 x Barrel Nut (D).








ASSEMBLY


Step 3. Attach 2 x Shelf Inserts (4) to the sub assembly from step 2.





PRODUCT USE

Step 4. Attach End Panel (1) to the sub assembly from step 3 by using 6×50 mm Bolts (A), 6×4 Wood Dowels (B) & 6×4 Barrel Nut (D).






PRODUCT USE

Step 5. Your 35114 Change Table Is now complete and ready to be used.

Note: Ensure that all Bolts are tightened before use!
